JOB SUMMARY

Under the immediate supervision of the Director, the project coordinator will manage, develop, plan, and implement nutrition education grant activities, perform administrative duties needed to budget and manage expenditures, and maintain records and reports. The coordinator will also keep inventory logs, set up electronic visual aids for grant activities and online surveys and Zoom Classes, assist in the distribution of handouts, healthy recipes, and cookbooks, and assist the Dieticians as needed. Develop and/or implements community tribal wellness policies, practices, or prompts at the FDPR distribution site level and community events, gatherings, and celebrations. Initiatives can include point-of-decision signage and other behavioral cues to action to promote FDPIR foods and healthy eating. Formulate healthy eating literature and will work to garner support from Tribal Leadership in introducing policy that will support healthy meal preparation and consumption. Improve nutrition-related skills by demonstrating how to use foods included in the USDA FDPIR food package. Provide Healthy Cooking Demo/Class Provide Nutrition Education/Wellness Class each month, Nutrition Staff will develop and distribute recipes promoting fruits and vegetables. My plate Handouts will also be distributed, promoting fruits, vegetable, water, and physical activity.
